



# Cameron-Drummond-Slagsvold Building

15-21 South Barstow Street  
1893-94, Romanesque Revival



This structure features massive rough stonework at the basement and first floor levels and red brick on the upper two floors. Typical of this type of Victorian architecture are the round tower and decorative brickwork. This is the largest building in the city remaining from this architectural period.

The most prominent commercial tenant was the Chippewa Valley Band, established by Byron Buffington, H.C. Putnam, T.F. Frawley and A.H. Holen, Another important tenant was Samuelson's Department Store.
