



# George Winslow House

210 Oakwood Place  
1889, Queen Anne



Carrie Foster, daughter of a prominent lumbering and railroad businessman, married George Winslow in 1889. Mr. Winslow published the *Woodsmen Journal* and manufactured and distributed to the lumbermen of northern Wisconsin patent medicines known as "camp remedies," including magnetic oil liniment, magnetic bomb, and blood purifier. The basic ingredient of all was alcohol.

Middle class Victorians commonly purchased modestly priced mail order house plans designed by architects. This plan was purchased from Tennessee architect George F. Barber. An unusual feature of the house is the distinctive chimney, which frames a window.
