



Hoover Memorial Chapel

Lakeview Cemetery
1936, Neo-Gothic Revival



Designed by John Tilton of the Chicago firm Armstrong, Furst and Tilton, this chapel was built at a cost of \$25,000 and was financed by Fannie Hoover Buffington, in memory of her parents. The chapel retains excellent integrity and was refurbished by members of Christ Church Cathedral in 2001.

The chapel lacks the ornamentation of Neo-Gothic Revival buildings built before 1936, but retains many of the noted features of this style such as the random ashlar construction, buttresses, Gothic-arched openings and a rose window.
