



James Wickham House

1705 Park Avenue
c. 1926, Colonial Revival



This two and one-half story white stucco residence displays decorative elements of classical and Spanish influence. The main façade is dominated by a combination of a classical portico and French doors in window bays. Three dormers rest on the gabled roof and feature arched caps with end flares.

James Wickham, an attorney, established the well-known firm of Wickham & Farr and served as City Attorney in 1897 and from 1899 to 1905. He also served as a circuit court judge until 1944.
