Terra cotta glazed tiles, often of cream and light turquoise color, frequently accented the upper stories of commercial buildings in the 1920s. The clay tile roof expresses a Mediterranean flavor.

Oliver Pear, an architect who resided in Eau Claire from 1923 to 1929, designed the building.
