



Orlando Brice House

120 Marston Avenue
1918, Georgian Revival



This stately residence is the most significant example of this style of architecture in Eau Claire. Three pedimented dormers project from the sloping roof surface and encompass rounded windows. A semi-circular Doric portico identifies the main entrance.

Orlando G. Brice was the treasurer and general manager of the Wisconsin Refrigerator Company, an Eau Claire firm noted for its production of the "Wisconsin Peerless" refrigerator. Brice and his family resided in the house until 1934.
