



Pearl Chambers House

1615 State Street

1928, Colonial Revival



The main façade of this colonial Revival residence is dominated by a classical style portico of six Doric columns and two pilasters. Sidelights and a fanlight window surround the main entrance door.

Edward Hancock designed this house for the owners Pearl and Evan Chambers. Pearl was vice-president of the New Dells Lumber Company, which was located on the Chippewa River to the north of Madison Street. The influence of the lumber industry can be seen in the interior of the house where decorative woodwork is featured.
